### NATIONAL COMMANDER VISITS SOUTHERN MAINE

State Commander Randall Kluj of Joseph P. Chaisson Post 41, Milo announced that the National Commander, Denise H. Rohan of Wisconsin will be making her official visit to the State of Maine September 28-30, 2017.

Commander Kluj stated that National Commander Rohan will arrive in Portland in the afternoon of September 28. On Friday, September 29, Commander Rohan will visit the Webber-Lefebvre Post 74 in Kennebunk for a meet and greet session and then travel to the Kennebunkport Memorial Post 159 in Kennebunkport for a visit with post members and guests. She will then make her way to a special visitation scheduled for noontime and proceed to The American Legion State Headquarters in Winslow for a tour of the facility. In the evening of September 29, National Commander Rohan will travel to the Ramsdell-Rogers Post 56 in York for a fish fry dinner and special presentations.

On Saturday morning, September 30, Commander Rohan is scheduled to arrive at the West-Day Post 123 in Parsonfield (Kezar Falls) to have breakfast with post members and guests. In the afternoon, she will then travel to the Charles S. Hatch Post 79 in Berwick for lunch and a meet and greet session. Saturday evening, a banquet in honor of National Commander Rohan will be held at the Thomas W. Cole Post 19 in Sanford. The National Commander will be departing the area on Sunday morning to make another visit to another Department as the next of her many stops during her year as Commander of the world's largest veteran's organization, The American Legion.

All veterans in the area of Commander Rohan's visits are welcome to attend whether they are members of The American Legion or not. It is hoped that a good turnout will be at all locations and that we show the National Commander what we think of our veterans in the state of Maine at each area she visits.
