PARADE: Buses will start departing the Convention at 9 a.m., by order of Post # (i.e. 1, 2, 3, 4, etc.) The parade will kick-off at 11 a.m. All buses should return by 2 p.m. when **Conventions will reconvene**. If you want to watch the parade, but not march, you may ride down on the buses also. For anyone who cannot ride the bus, there will be parking available on Exchange Street, or along the parade route. The parade will be held rain or shine. More information can be found below.

CONCESSIONS: will be open in the tent, behind the building (outside access), on Friday and Saturday for beverages and food.

Saturday – Concession will be open for purchase.

Sign-up for box lunches MUST be ordered prior to leaving for the parade.

Box lunch choices will be Ham, Turkey or Veggie sandwich, with chips, cookie and beverage for \$10.00 (these are large sandwiches and very filling). Gluten-free available.

INSTALLATION: will immediately follow the close of Department Convention. All newly elected Legion, Auxiliary and SAL State Officers will be installed at that time. Estimated time of installation is 5:30 p.m.

100th State Convention Parade Information

If you are planning to march in the 100th State Convention Parade, all Posts, Units, and Squadrons are to assemble at the Spectacular Event Center in Bangor at 9:00 a.m., Saturday, June 16, 2018. Parking for personal vehicles will be available at Spectacular Event Center or parking area across the street.

- 1. Starting with Rockland Post 1, the Legionnaires, Auxiliary and Sons of the American Legion of Post 1 will board the first bus. You will carry all of your flags, rifles, banners, etc. when boarding the buses.
- 2. If space is available, Augusta Post 2 will board the same bus. The following procedure will continue in numerical order until completion.
- 3. Upon arrival of parade staging area, your Post will be directed for formation and departure of parade.
- 4. Buses will rotate from Spectacular Event Center in Bangor to staging areas which is located at the intersection of Exchange Street and State Street.
- 5. If you are planning to have any type of military vehicle or float (no personal vehicles), please contact Doug Damon at 207-949-4735 or via email at dougdamon@live.com.
- 6. After completion of parade, the buses will return all participants and equipment back to the convention center where the convention agenda will continue.

Note: a. Portable toilets will be available at parade site.

b. Each Post will decide on the color or what they will wear for the parade attire. Please keep in mind Legion, Auxiliary, SAL logo or military emblem. (NO OTHER ORGANIZATIONAL HATS ARE TO BE WORN).

IT'S YOUR PARADE!

The Parade Committee reserves the right to refuse participation to those not complying with these guidelines.

1. All vehicles must be certified by their owner/operator to be safe for the Parade.


2. All entries must be decorated and suitable for a family audience, as well as tasteful and in spirit of the event.

- 3. PLEASE DO NOT THROW CANDY FROM THE VEHICLES. Have walkers passing it out to the children/spectators along the edge of the street (close to the sidewalk). This is for the safety of our children and those driving the vehicles. Walkers must keep pace with the float and use a wagon/stroller for replenishment of candy supply.
- 4. Motorized vehicles must remain a safe distance apart (25 feet or more) during the parade.
- Drivers of motorized vehicles must be at least 18 years of age and have a valid driver's license. Drivers of all vehicles must be able to show proof of a driver's license and insurance.
- 6. All children under the age of 16 participating in the parade must be supervised by an adult. Adults MUST accompany and supervise children, youth organizations, school groups, or non-profit groups with children participating.
- Playing music too loud is not allowed. Music must be suitable for a family audience, tasteful and in spirit of the event.
- 8. All horse entries MUST provide a pooper-scooper.
- 9. No fireworks, explosives or other pyrotechnics are allowed along the parade route.
- 10. Units with sirens are asked not to use them and please use the lights only.
- 11. Non pre-registered vehicles may be placed in Div 5.

The Parade starts promptly at 11:00 am. All entrants must be in place and ready to go with their float or walking equipment by 10:30 am. This will make for a super parade if you help us with these recommendations.

Buses will take participants to Exchange Street, where everyone will be staged for the start of the parade. There are several parking lots which will be used.

The parade will march to the intersection of State Street, take a left down to Main Street. The reviewing stand will be in front of the USS Maine Memorial in Davenport Park. The parade will disband just after the reviewing stand, where buses will be to pick up marchers and return them to Spectacular Event Center.

Please assemble in one of the parking lots near the intersection of Exchange Street & State Street. There will be someone to guide you. 

On Saturday, June 16th at convention in Bangor, we will march in a Legion parade to honor the 100th anniversary of The American Legion. America's biggest Veterans organization. Keep watching the Smile, the Chatter & this e-mail newsletter for more details. June 16th is only 13 days away!

Gentlemen:

2018 Membership Report for 4 June 2018: We now have 2,504 members for 98.47% membership. Our May goal is 100% (2,543 members). We need 39 more members to make it. Keep asking those unpaid members to renew and keep sending those stubs & dues in to Detachment. Together, we can make 100% happen. We are currently 13th in the nation and third in the Eastern Region. Congratulations to the District of Columbia for being the second in the east to make 100% membership. We need to get a moving if we want to be next. FYI: We are still ahead of the Auxiliary who is currently at 90.13% and the Legion who is at 93.36% state wide. Who's going to get to 100% state membership first? Let's keep those memberships coming, guys. Convention is less than two weeks away!

The 100% Membership Club: Squadrons: 56 York, 57 Old Orchard, 17 Portland, 76 Scarborough, 86 Gray, 135 Sabattus, 150 Mechanic Falls, 153 New Auburn, 158 Lisbon, 28 Farmington, 24 Rumford, 100 Dixfield, 112 Oxford,1 Rockland, 21 Bath, 5 Waterville, 51 Oakland, 132 Richmond, 205 Augusta, 39 Madison, 99 Bingham, 75 Old Town, 29 Dover-Foxcroft, 94 Greenville, 3 Calais, 9 Machias, 65 Lubec, 49 Van Buren and 178 Headquarters are the first twenty nine club members.
